

Music Lessons with Mikala Petillo

Welcome! Music education to me is as important as any other form of learning. It enhances & instills problem solving, teamwork, goal setting, self-expression, hand eye coordination, memory skills, self-confidence, self esteem, and concentration in students of any age. It is my mission to guide students in finding and exploring their voice while enhancing and appreciating their musical skills.

The purpose of this contract is to set forth the understandings between us of the terms and conditions of music lessons. Please fill out/sign where appropriate.

The student will be taking the following type of lessons:

- Voice
- Guitar
- Ukulele
- Songwriting
- Piano

Tuition

The tuition will be \$151.00 per month for an hour lesson, payable at or before the first lesson of the month. If it is not paid for at or before the first lesson of the month, I will have the right to not give that lesson or subsequent lessons. The tuition is based on one lesson, and will not be reduced if you miss any lessons. There will be a \$10.00 late fee if payment is not made by or before the first lesson of the month.

Calendar

During holiday times on the calendar (where there is no school), we will not usually have lessons. In the event of severe weather please call me and speak to me regarding your lesson. If lessons are missed in either of these cases, every reasonable effort will be made to offer you an alternative makeup lesson time that works best for both of us.

Cancellations & Makeups

Cancellations have to be made known to me at least 24 hours prior to the scheduled lesson in order to reschedule that lesson at a later time. If a lesson is missed without a call/email notifying me of the cancellation the lesson will not be made-up. I do have discretion to offer a makeup lesson in unusual circumstances, I understand that life is hectic but my time is valuable and therefore I need to be notified ahead of time. Makeup lessons can be scheduled at any point if a student knows they will miss in advance.

Instruments

If you are taking lessons learning an instrument, you will need to have it available to you to practice at home and in lessons. It is your responsibility to provide the instrument, and bring it to lessons with you along with other materials (Tuner, Capo, Music, Etc.)

Practice

Choosing to further your musical learning will take time at home as well. To get maximum enjoyment, benefit and value out of your lessons please make sure you are practicing regularly at home as to not waste anyone's time or money during our weekly lessons. The best way to do this is to set aside time at home each day to practice. You are learning new material (music theory/songwriting) and new physical skills (playing an instrument/singing) and both require practice to make progress.

Termination of Lessons

At some point you may decide it is time to end lessons. If and when you should come to that decision, please give me a written notice signed by you, parent or guardian with your last months tuition. In short you would give notice the first lesson day of the last month of lessons.

Hopefully all of this is helpful to you, and if you decide to take lessons I suggest you keep this contract somewhere you can refer to it if any questions may appear. I will be happy to explain anything to you further as well. I am asking that you, parent or guardian sign below as evidence that you have read this completely and that you understand it thoroughly.
